

## **Rear Sway Bar Installation Instructions**

## Tools Required:

- Hydraulic jack and jack stands
- 5/8" wrench and socket

## Installation:

- 1. Lift the rear of the vehicle and safely support with jack stands under the frame rails.
- If the vehicle came equipped with a factory rear sway bar, remove the sway bar by un-bolting it from the control arms.
- 3. If your vehicle did not come with a factory rear sway bar you must either upgrade to an aftermarket set of lower control arms or upgrade your factory control arms with the reinforcements shown in **IMAGE 1**.
- 4. Using the provided hardware, bolt the BMR sway bar to the lower control arms and tighten the bolts with a 5/8" wrench and socket. torque to **45 ft lbs.**
- 5. Lower vehicle.
